First Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Opening Psalm (*Marmitha*):

Celebrant: Sing to the Lord a new song; **Halleluiah**

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord a new song;

Celebrant: Sing to the Lord all the earth!

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord, bless His Name;

Celebrant: Tell of His salvation from day to day.

People & Servers: Declare His glory among the nations! His marvelous works among all the peoples!

Celebrant: He will judge the world with Truth; **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And the Peoples with justice! **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*'Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: **Hear this, all peoples:** The angel Gabriel declared to Zechariah, “You shall have a son, and you are to name him John. He will prepare the way before the Son of the King, Who comes in glory to save all creatures.

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

Celebrant: There is none like You among the gods, O Lord; **Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: There is none like You among the gods, O Lord, nor are there any works like Yours. All the nations You have made shall come and bow down before You, O Lord.

Celebrant: Halleluiah, Halleluiah.

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: Hear us, O Shepherd of Israel, You Who lead Joseph like a flock!
You Who are enthroned upon the cherubim, shine forth! Stir up
Your might, and come to save us! - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*'Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: Hoping I hoped in the Lord: The Precious Body and
Blood of Christ are on the holy altar. Let us draw near to Him in
reverence and in love and with the angels let us sing: holy, holy,
holy is the Lord our God.

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: May the Son Who has given us His Body and Blood,
grant us life in His Kingdom!

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*) Verses:

People & Servers: On this first day, which is the first of the days, come let
us receive the Body and Blood of Him Who is the First-born of God.

Second Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Opening Psalm (*Marmitha*):

Celebrant: The Lord reigns; let the earth rejoice; **Halleluiah**

People & Servers: The Lord reigns; let the earth rejoice;

Celebrant: The heavens proclaim His righteousness;

People & Servers: And all the peoples behold His glory.

Celebrant: All worshipers of images are put to shame,

People & Servers: Who make their boast in worthless idols;

Celebrant: He will judge the world with Truth; **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And the Peoples with justice! **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*‘Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: And the Lord will give His blessings: In this month of December where the earth bears no fruit, the Lord wished to bear fruit through a Virgin. He is the cause of all goodness, and the good hope of all creation. He is the true light, Christ the Lord of all who is worshiped with His Father and His Holy Spirit.

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

Celebrant: We have heard with our ears, O God: **Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

Servers & People: We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, what deeds You performed in their days, in the days of old.

Celebrant: Halleluiah, Halleluiah.

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

Second Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: We have thought on Your mercy, O God, in the midst of Your temple. As Your Name, O God, so Your praise reaches to the ends of the earth. - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*'Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: **My heart is ready, O God, my heart is ready:** With reverence and love, let us prepare for the awesome gift of Christ's Holy Mysteries. Let us adorn our souls with good works so that he may show us mercy on the day of judgment.

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: O people, rejoice before our Savior: for you are now to partake of His Bread in His presence!

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*) Verses:

People & Servers: Brothers and sisters, give thanks to the Merciful One Who has freely pardoned your sins. Now become partakers in the Mystery that is praised by the angels.

Third Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Opening Psalm (*Marmitha*):

Celebrant: Sing to the Lord a new song; **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord a new song;

Celebrant: For he has done marvelous things!

People & Servers: His right hand and His holy arm have gotten him victory.

Celebrant: The Lord has made known His victory,

People & Servers: He has revealed His vindication in the sight of the nations.

Celebrant: He will judge the world with Truth; **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And the Peoples with justice! **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*'Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: Announce His salvation from day to day: The annunciation that Mary accepted contained all salvation. She conceived Christ without seed or relations. The Holy Spirit alone descended on her and overshadowed her with the power of the Most High. She is blest among all women, for the hope that she is filled with; Blessed be the Creator Who had mercy on us.

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

Celebrant: When the Almighty placed a king, snow fell on the mountain of God; **Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: When the Almighty placed a king, snow fell on the mountain of God. O mighty mountain of Bashan, why do you look with envy at the mount which God desired for His abode, yes, where the Lord will dwell forever.

Celebrant: Halleluiah, Halleluiah.

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

Third Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Servers: I have made a covenant with my chosen one, I have sworn to David my servant: “I will establish your descendants forever, and build your throne for all generations.” - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*‘Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: **Your throne, O God, is forever:** O mighty Lord, the angels surround Your glorious throne. The seraphim in awe worship before You and dare not to behold Your Face. Instead, they sing at all times: “holy, holy, holy are You.” O lover of mankind, praise to You.

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: Prophets and kings longed for Your Body and forgiving Blood.

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*) Verses:

People & Servers: David longed and asked but did not drink of the water that he sought. Give thanks for you have been made worthy to drink of the chalice of Christ!

Fourth Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Opening Psalm (*Marmitha*):

Celebrant: Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples, **Halleluiah**

People & Servers: Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples,

Celebrant: Ascribe to the Lord glory and strength!

People & Servers: Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His Name;

Celebrant: Bring an offering and come into His courts!

People & Servers: Worship the Lord in holy attire;

Celebrant: He will judge the world with Truth; **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And the Peoples with justice! **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*'Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: Behold and see new things have been done: Mary was disturbed at the things the angel said. She who knew not man conceived by the Spirit's power. He Who made Adam from dust, and from him formed Eve without seed, and made the barren Sarah fertile and then Rebecca, is the one Who confirmed the virgin through Elizabeth.

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

Celebrant: Mighty King, lover of justice; **Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: Mighty King, lover of justice, You have established equity; You have executed justice and righteousness in Jacob. Extol the Lord our God; worship at His footstool! Holy is he! Moses and Aaron were among His priests; Samuel also was among those who called on His Name.

Celebrant: Halleluiah, Halleluiah.

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

Fourth Sunday of Advent (*Subara*)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Servers: Yours is dominion on the day You lead Your host in holy splendor. From the womb and from all ages I begot You. The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind, “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.” The Lord is at Your right hand; - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*‘Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: I will proclaim to you peace: The angel's greeting left Mary troubled. She who knew not man conceived by the Spirit's power. Peace on earth, glory in heaven and good hope to all mankind! Blessed be the Father's only Son Who took on our humanity and gives consolation to mortal man.

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: Let us give thanks to Christ in His holy Church, for He gives us His Body!

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*) Verses:

People & Servers: The people butchered the Lamb of Life, and other peoples came and were healed. It brought judgment for them but joy for us. Praise God in His sanctuary; praise him in His mighty firmament, to Christ Who gives us His Flesh.

The Feast of the Nativity (*Yalda*)

(December 25)

Opening Psalm (*Marmitha*):

Celebrant: Sing to the Lord a new song; **Halleluiah**

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord a new song;

Celebrant: Sing to the Lord all the earth!

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord, bless His Name;

Celebrant: Tell of His salvation from day to day.

People & Servers: Declare His glory among the nations! His marvelous works among all the peoples!

Celebrant: I will thank You in the great assembly! **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And praise You among many people. **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*'Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: From all ages, a son I begot **You:** Your birth was hidden from the angels on high who praise You, O Lord. Without leaving Your throne before the cherubim, You filled the earth by Your manifestation in the flesh! With the angels we sing: "Glory to God in the highest" and with the shepherds we proclaim, "Peace on earth." O Good Hope for our souls, forgive and have mercy on us!

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

Celebrant: A Mighty One has been born in her and has made her strong for the birth of Christ which we celebrate with hymns of the Spirit. **Halleluiah, Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: Those who dwell in You, all shall now rejoice for He is born there; for the birth of Christ which we celebrate with hymns of the Spirit. **Halleluiah, Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

The Feast of the Nativity (Yalda)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: The Lord said to me, “You are my son, today I have begotten You. Ask of me, and I will make the nations Your heritage, and the ends of the earth Your possession. - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*‘Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord a new song: Glory and great joy have filled the whole world at Christ the King’s nativity. The heavenly hosts of angels join with us to sing and proclaim: “Glory to God in the highest, peace and harmony on earth.” The Only-begotten son has appeared to us in the flesh. His power has been proclaimed to all peoples and he has ascended in glory to His Father.

Hymn: Awesome Are You (*d-Hilat*):

(Said during the Feasts of our Lord)

Celebrant: Awesome are You, Most High God, in Your holy sanctuary forever and ever! Blessed be the glory of the Lord, from His holy dwelling place!

People & Servers: The Coal which the prophet saw, the angel held with tongs. But now in the sanctuary, the priests bear it in their hands! Come, let us draw near to Him with holiness in body and soul. This is indeed the Mystery which was hidden and is given for our sake for the remission of sins. **Halleluiah!**

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: The Body and redeeming Blood are offered on the living and life-giving altar here in this holy Church; from which it will be received on the holy, glorious and spiritual altar, the true one in Heaven above.

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*) Verses:

People & Servers: Behold, the Virgin has conceived and bore a Son, and His Name is Emmanuel! For to us is born this day in the city of David, a Savior, Who is Christ the Lord. For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and His Name will be called: “Wonderful Counselor.”

Celebrant: I will thank You in the great assembly! **Halleluiah.**

People & Servers: And praise You among many people. **Halleluiah.**

Celebrant: Halleluiah. Halleluiah. E-Halleluiah.

People & Servers: Let us pray, peace be with us.

Hymn of the Holy of Holies (*‘Onytha d-Qanke*):

Servers: I will extol You, my God and King: The cherubim surround Your awesome throne of glory, O Lord. They veil their faces in fear, not able to raise their eyes and look upon that great fire of Your Divinity. But You Who are so glorious came to dwell among men not to burn them by Your Fire, but to enlighten them. Great is Your mercy and grace manifested to our race. Glory to You!

Psalm between the Readings (*Shuraya*):

People & Servers: With the oil of gladness above Your companions; for the baptism of Christ which we celebrate with hymns of the Spirit. **Halleluiah, Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

The Feast of Epiphany (*Denħa*)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: My heart overflows with a goodly theme; I address my verses to the king; my tongue is like the pen of a ready scribe. Therefore, God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above Your fellows; Your robes are all fragrant with myrrh and aloes and cassia.
- Halleluiah.

Hymn of the Mysteries (*‘Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: Sing to the Lord a new song: Creation has now been renewed by its Lord, and it recognizes her Savior. In the Jordan's streams He was baptized and revealed the Blessed Trinity; The Father called out and said: 'This is My Beloved Son, in Him I am pleased!' And the Spirit came and rested on Him, and revealed His glory to all.

Hymn: Awesome Are You (*d-Hilat*):

(Said during the Feasts of our Lord. Note: *d-Hilat* is not prayed in full, but instead only the verses).

People & Servers: A voice from the heavens said: "This is My Beloved Son, and in Him I am well-pleased!" Let us all remain in Him and serve His great majesty with our whole heart as we sing: "Holy are You, Holy are You, Holy are You Lord, Lover of the human race!"

Communion Hymn (*‘Onytha d-Wem*):

The Feast of Epiphany (*Denħa*)

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: The Lord reigns; he is robed in majesty; the Lord is robed, he is girded with strength. Yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved; Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting. - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*'Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: **The Lord reigns, He is robed with majesty:** Renewed by water and the Spirit's power, the faithful put-on incorruptibility. From the time our Savior was baptized in the Jordan's streams, the nature of springs has been filled with holiness! Water no longer shall destroy by flood all created things for in the Jordan, Christ appeared and forgave our transgressions; sinners will not be submerged by the flood, but instead in a font be baptized, and be saved! Put on incorruptibility through water and Spirit, you faithful, and cry out with all your heart: O Christ, You have enriched our souls, glory be to You!

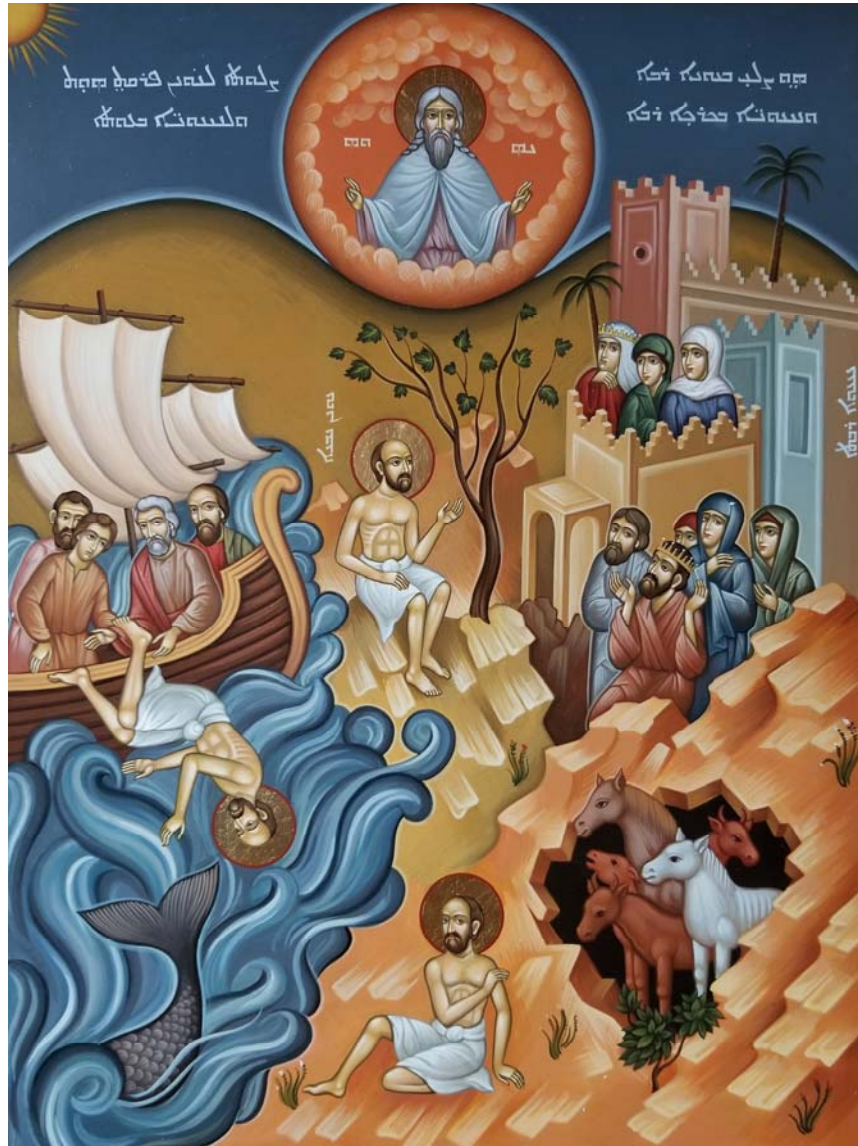

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*):

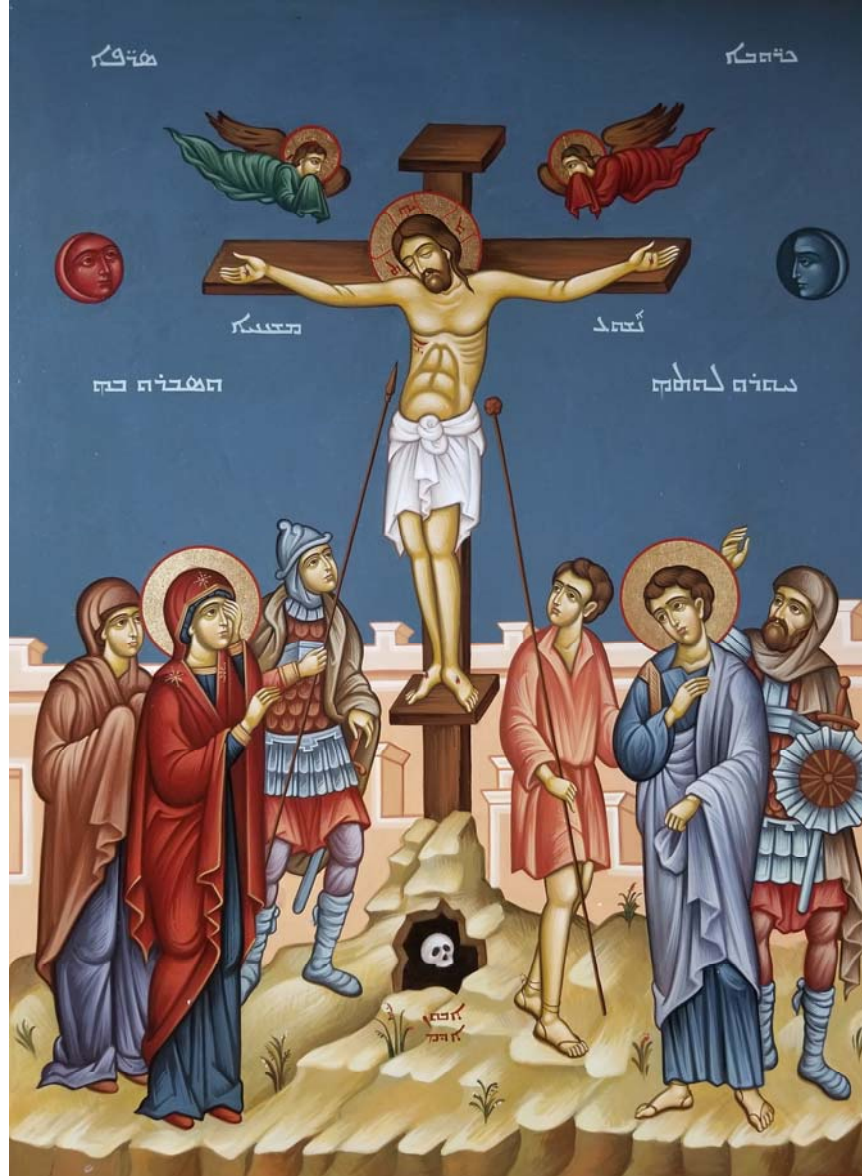

People & Servers: He has adorned her clothing with costly gold; for the memorial of the Virgin which we celebrate with hymns of the Spirit. **Halleluiah, Halleluiah, Halleluiah.**

Servers: Let us pray. Peace be with us.

Memorial of the Immaculate Conception

Gospel Psalm (*Zumara*):

Server: Hear, O daughter, consider, and incline your ear; forget your people and your father's house; and the king will desire your beauty. The daughter of the king is decked in her chamber with gold-woven robes; in many-colored robes she is led to the king, with her virgin companions, her escort, in her train. - **Halleluiah.**

Hymn of the Mysteries (*'Onytha d-Raze*):

People & Servers: Come, hear and I will declare to you: The end had approached for the pure body that bore the Son of God. It was time to drink the cup which Adam had prepared for his children. The Lord commanded the angels to honor the body of His mother. They fulfilled the command of their Master and accompanied her with reverence and honor just as was commanded them. Praised be God Who honored her death!

Communion Hymn (*'Onytha d-Wem*):

People & Servers: Let us all partake of the incorruptible Body and the chalice of the precious Blood of Christ, the Savior of us all. Our hope is in His death for us all and our faith is in His Resurrection. It is right to join the angels and sing to Him: Halleluiah!
